- Udbhav Vasudevan (Grade 10) qualified for the National Round of the World Robot Olympiad in Ahmedabad, securing 10th place in the Junior Category. He achieved a Top 10 overall position at IIT Kanpur's Techkriti in the event Manoeuvre and participated in IIT Bombay's Techfest 2025, where his team secured 3rd place in two events. He also earned 2nd place in the Techfest Olympiad at the Bengaluru Zonal Round. His most significant accomplishment was at the 2025 MATE ROV World Championship, where his team ranked 1st in India, earning the honour of representing the nation at the global finals in Michigan, USA.
- Pranjal Jain (Grade 10) qualified for and attended the IOITC at the Chennai Mathematical Institute. His deep proficiency in artificial intelligence led him to the INAIOTC at IIIT Hyderabad, the fourth stage of the Indian National Artificial Intelligence Olympiad. He achieved national recognition by securing an impressive rank of 57 in the prestigious HPE Codewars competition.

Textbooks & Notebooks for the Next Academic Year:- In response to parents' requests, the school has arranged for the availability of textbooks and materials from various agencies on campus. These will be distributed to students to ensure a smooth start to the academic year without any delays. The prescribed cost and the schedule for book distribution will be communicated separately.

School Fees:- As per school policy, we do not collect any donations or capitation fees. Being a private, self-financing institution, National Public School implements an annual fee increase of 7.5% to 10% to accommodate rising expenditures. This adjustment accounts for various factors, including staff salaries, government-mandated increases in property taxes, rising utility costs, infrastructure maintenance, and the upkeep of laboratories, computers, and AMCs.

The annual fees for the academic year 2026-27 should be remitted between 20th March 2026 and 05th April 2026 through the payment link available on the Acadamis Parent Portal or Parent App. It will be presumed that students who do not complete the fee payment by the due date will not be continuing for the next academic year.
