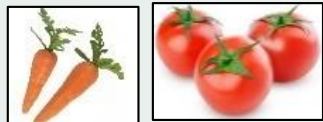
SENIORS - WEEK 1

SCHEDULE



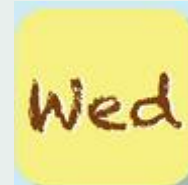
Wash

Fill a tub with clean water. Ask your grown-up if you can wash your family's fruits and vegetables. Wipe them gently and put them on a clean towel to dry. Count the number of fruits and veggies you have cleaned. You have become an amazing 'Helper'. Remember to make a pictorial list of what you cleaned.
